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### LAMANA INSTRUCTION



### HAT #06/24

**SIZE** M (54–57 cm)

 $\label{eq:matrix} \textbf{MATERIALS} \ Lamana \ Cusco \ (100\% \ Baby \ Alpaca, \ approx. \ 85 \ m/50 \ g) \ 100 \ g \ in \ colour \ Caramel \ shade \ 30, \\ 4 \ mm \ and \ 5 \ mm \ knitting \ needles, \ tapestry \ needle$ 

**PATTERN NOTE** Rib pattern: RS rows: \*k1, p1, rep from \* to end; WS rows: work sts as they appear Main pattern: Rows 1 - 8: stocking st (RS rows: k all sts, WS rows: p all sts)

Row 9 (RS): 1 selvedge st, \*k2, pick up and knit next st 6 rows below (this pulls loose horizontal strands of dropped sts together), k1, rep from \* to last st, 1 selvedge st

Rows 10–16: stocking st

Row 17 (RS): 1 selvedge st, \*pick up and knit next st 6 rows below, k3, rep from \* to last st, 1 selvedge st Row 18 (WS): purl all sts. Repeat rows 3 - 18 for pattern. Note: the WS of work will later be the outside of hat! Gauge: 18 sts and 38 rows in main pattern with 5 mm needles =  $10 \times 10$  cm

**HOW TO** CO 98 sts with 4 mm needles and work in rib pattern for 8 rows. Change to 5 mm needles and continue in main pattern until work measures 23 cm from cast-on edge, ending with row 10 or row 18 of main pattern. Next RS row: 1 selvedge st, \*k2tog, k2, rep from \* to last st, 1 selvedge st (= 74 sts left). Next WS row: purl all sts. Next RS row: 1 selvedge st, \*k2tog, k1, rep from \* to last st, 1 selvedge st (= 50 sts left). Next WS row: purl all sts. Next RS row: 1 selvedge st, \*k2tog, rep from \* to last st, 1 selvedge st (= 26 sts left). Next WS row: purl all sts. Next RS row: 1 selvedge st, \*k2tog, rep from \* to last st, 1 selvedge st (= 26 sts left). Next WS row: purl all sts. Next RS row: k2tog throughout (= 13 sts left). Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread through remaining sts and secure.


**TO FINISH** Turn inside out. Join back seam and weave in ends. Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry.
