### LAMANA INSTRUCTION



### **BABY BEANIE #01/06**

SIZE 3-6 months (head circumference 40-44 cm)

(B)

**MATERIALS** Lamana Como (100% Merino Superfine, approx. 120 m/25 g) 25 g in colour Jeans shade 12M, 4.5 mm knitting needles (UK/US 7), tapestry needle

#### **PATTERN NOTE** Main pattern:

Row 1 (RS): s, \*k 1, p 1\*, rep from \* to last st, s

Row 2 (WS): work sts as they appear

Row 3 (RS): s, \*p 1, k 1\*, rep from \* to last st, s

Row 4 (WS): work sts as they appear. Rep rows 1-4.

Gauge: 23 sts and 38 rows in main pattern =  $10 \times 10$  cm

**HOW TO** The beanie is worked sideways starting at centre back. CO 42 sts and work in pattern for 2 rows, then work next 2 rows as follows:

\*\* Row 1 (RS): s, k 1, yo, continue in pattern to last 4 sts, work next 2 sts tog (i.e. k/p tog these 2 sts according to pattern), k 1, s

Row 2 (WS): work sts as they appear, k yo tbl.

Repeat these 2 rows until work measures 6 cm. Now work next 2 rows as follows:

Row 1 (RS): s, k 1, work next 2 sts tog (i.e. k/p tog these 2 sts according to pattern), cont in patt to last 2 sts, yo, k 1, s.

Row 2 (WS): work sts as they appear, k yo tbl. Repeat these 2 rows for further 6 cm (= 1st ear flap).\*\*
Repeat from \*\* to \*\* 2 more times. There are now 2 more curves, one for centre forehead and one for 2nd ear flap. When work measures 36 cm BO all sts.



**TO FINISH** Close seams with small hand stitches and RS side facing you as follows: on left side of work (where you can see 2 half triangles and 2 full triangles) connect first half triangle with nearest side of first full triangle, then connect rem side of 1st full triangle with nearest side of 2nd full triangle and finally rem side of 2nd full triangle with last half triangle. Close back seam, weave in ends. Let piece dry under wet cloth.
